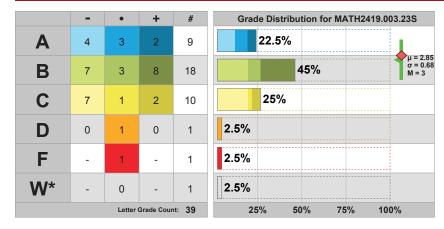
confused.
